

HOUSE SUNSET COMMITTEE AMENDMENT

Committee on Public Health Care and Human Services

LLS No. 20-0516 be amended as follows:

- 1 Amend LLS No. 20-0516, page 7, strike lines 17 through 27.
- 2 Strike pages 8 and 9.
- 3 Page 10, strike lines 1 through 18.
- 4 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
- 5 Page 11, strike line 24 and substitute "(2) introductory portion and (2)(b);
- 6 and **repeal** (3) as follows:
 - 7 Page 12, after line 1 insert:
 - 8 "(b) Three board members must be representatives of the general
 - 9 public. ~~one of whom may be a mental health consumer or family member~~
 - 10 ~~of a mental health consumer. These individuals must have never been~~
 - 11 ~~psychologists, applicants or former applicants for licensure as~~
 - 12 ~~psychologists, members of another mental health profession, or members~~
 - 13 ~~of households that include psychologists or members of another mental~~
 - 14 ~~health profession or otherwise have conflicts of interest or the appearance~~
 - 15 ~~of conflicts with their duties as board members.~~
 - 16 (3) (a) ~~Each board member shall hold office until the expiration~~
 - 17 ~~of the member's appointed term or until a successor is duly appointed.~~
 - 18 ~~Except as specified in subsection (3)(b) of this section, the term of each~~
 - 19 ~~member shall be four years, and no board member shall serve more than~~
 - 20 ~~two full consecutive terms. Any vacancy occurring in board membership~~
 - 21 ~~other than by expiration of a term shall be filled by the governor by~~
 - 22 ~~appointment for the unexpired term of the member.~~
 - 23 (b) ~~The terms of office of the members on the board are modified~~
 - 24 ~~as follows in order to ensure staggered terms of office:~~
 - 25 (i) ~~The second term of office of the licensed psychologist board~~
 - 26 ~~member and one of the two board members representing the general~~
 - 27 ~~public, whose second term would otherwise expire on June 30, 2010,~~
 - 28 ~~shall expire on May 31, 2008, and the governor shall appoint one new~~
 - 29 ~~licensed psychologist and one new representative of the general public to~~
 - 30 ~~serve terms as described in subsection (3)(a) of this section commencing~~

1 on June 1, 2008:

2 ~~(II) The initial term of office of the one board member~~
3 ~~representing the general public whose initial term would otherwise expire~~
4 ~~on June 30, 2009, shall expire on May 31, 2009, and the board member~~
5 ~~is eligible to serve one additional four-year term commencing on June 1,~~
6 ~~2009, and expiring on May 31, 2013. On and after the expiration of this~~
7 ~~board member's term or a vacancy in this position, the governor shall~~
8 ~~appoint a licensed psychologist to this position on the board, who is~~
9 ~~eligible to serve terms as described in subsection (3)(a) of this section~~
10 ~~commencing on June 1 of the applicable year.~~

11 ~~(III) The initial term of office of one of the two licensed~~
12 ~~psychologist board members whose initial term would otherwise expire~~
13 ~~on June 30, 2010, shall expire on May 31, 2009. This board member shall~~
14 ~~be eligible to serve one additional four-year term, commencing on June~~
15 ~~1, 2009, and expiring on May 31, 2013. On and after the expiration of this~~
16 ~~board member's term, persons appointed to this position on the board~~
17 ~~shall serve terms as described in subsection (3)(a) of this section~~
18 ~~commencing on June 1 of the applicable year.~~

19 ~~(IV) The initial terms of office of the remaining licensed~~
20 ~~psychologist board member and the other board member representing the~~
21 ~~general public, whose initial terms would otherwise expire on June 30,~~
22 ~~2010, shall expire on May 31, 2010. Each of these board members shall~~
23 ~~be eligible to serve one additional four-year term commencing on June 1,~~
24 ~~2010, and expiring on May 31, 2014. On and after the expiration of these~~
25 ~~board members' terms, persons appointed to these positions on the board~~
26 ~~shall serve terms as described in subsection (3)(a) of this section~~
27 ~~commencing on June 1 of the applicable year.~~

28 ~~(V) The second term of office of the remaining board member~~
29 ~~representing the general public whose second term would otherwise~~
30 ~~expire on June 30, 2010, shall expire on May 31, 2010. The governor~~
31 ~~shall appoint one new representative of the general public to serve terms~~
32 ~~as described in subsection (3)(a) of this section commencing on June 1,~~
33 ~~2010.~~

34 **SECTION 12.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-245-304, amend
35 (1)(d) and (1)(e); and add (1)(f) as follows:

36 **12-245-304. Qualifications - examinations - licensure.** (1) The
37 board shall issue a license as a psychologist to each applicant who files
38 an application in a form and manner required by the board, submits the
39 fee required by the board pursuant to section 12-245-205, and furnishes
40 evidence satisfactory to the board that the applicant:

1 (d) Has had at least one year of postdoctoral experience practicing
2 psychology under supervision approved by the board; and
3 (e) Demonstrates professional competence by passing a single,
4 written examination in psychology as prescribed by the board and a
5 jurisprudence examination administered by the division; AND
6 (f) ON AND AFTER THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SUBSECTION (1)(f),
7 UPON THE INITIAL APPLICATION FOR LICENSURE HAS COMPLETED A
8 NAME-BASED CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD CHECK, AS DEFINED IN SECTION
9 22-2-119.3 (6)(d), WITH SATISFACTORY RESULTS AS DETERMINED BY THE
10 BOARD."
