HB20-1206 be amended as follows:

1 Amend printed bill, page 19, after line 4 insert:

2 "SECTION 24. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-245-501, add  
3 (2.5) as follows:

4 **12-245-501. Definitions.** As used in this part 5, unless the context  
5 otherwise requires:

6 (2.5) "CLINICAL SUPERVISION" MEANS:

7 (a) THE EVALUATION AND MODIFICATION OR APPROVAL BY A  
8 SUPERVISOR OF THE CLINICAL PRACTICE OF THE PERSON BEING  
9 SUPERVISED; AND

10 (b) A SOURCE OF KNOWLEDGE, EXPERTISE, AND MORE ADVANCED  
11 SKILLS MADE AVAILABLE TO THE PERSON BEING SUPERVISED.

12 **SECTION 25.** In Colorado Revised Statutes, 12-245-504, amend  
13 (1)(d) as follows:

14 **12-245-504. Qualifications - examination - licensure and**  
15 **registration.** (1) The board shall issue a license as a marriage and family  
16 therapist to each applicant who files an application in a form and manner  
17 required by the board, submits the fee required by the board pursuant to  
18 section 12-245-205, and furnishes evidence satisfactory to the board that  
19 the applicant:

20 (d) Subsequent to completing ~~his or her~~ THE APPLICANT'S master's  
21 or doctoral degree, has had at least two years of post-master's or one year  
22 of postdoctoral practice in individual and marriage and family therapy,  
23 including at least one thousand five hundred hours of face-to-face direct  
24 client contact as determined by the board for the purpose of assessment  
25 and intervention under ~~board-approved~~ CLINICAL supervision THAT MAY  
26 BE IN-PERSON OR TELESUPERVISION; and".

27 Renumber succeeding sections accordingly.
