Members of Finance Committee:

**I am writing to voice DOR/MED support for HB 1424.** The Division supports efforts to expand on social equity initiatives in the Colorado cannabis industry, and greatly appreciates the opportunity to work collaboratively with stakeholders to get this bill right. HB 1424 replaces the Accelerator License established in last year's HB19-224 (MJ Sunset bill) with a Social Equity License and applies a broader application based on stakeholder feedback.

More detailed background:

In 2019, the General Assembly enacted SB 224 Regulated Marijuana Sunset, which directed the State Licensing Authority to create and implement an accelerator program beginning July 1, 2020. SB 224 extended the program to retail marijuana cultivation and retail marijuana products manufacturing activities, allowing for eligible licensees to host and offer technical and capital support to accelerator licensees. Accelerator Licensees are currently defined as persons residing in an "opportunity zone" as designated by the Office of Economic Development and International Trade ("OEDIT").

As part of the rulemaking process the Division held 2 stakeholder work group sessions to solicit feedback on the rules for the accelerator program. It was clear in those discussions that many stakeholders wanted to expand the program beyond persons residing in an "opportunity zone". HB 1424 replaces the Accelerator Licensee with a Social Equity Licensee. This also allows for a broader application of the Social Equity License and adds additional criteria:

- A. Is a Colorado resident;

- B. Has not been the beneficial owner of a license subject to disciplinary or legal action from the state resulting in the revocation of a license issued pursuant to this article 10;
- C. Has demonstrated at least one of the following:
- a. the applicant has resided for at least fifteen years between the years 1980 and 2010 in a census tract designated by the office of economic development and international trade as an opportunity zone or
  - b. designated as a disproportionate impacted area as defined by rule pursuant to section 44-10-203(1)(j);
  - c. (ii) the applicant or the applicant's parent, legal guardian, sibling, spouse, child, or minor in their guardianship was arrested for a marijuana offense, convicted of a marijuana offense, or was subject to civil asset forfeiture related to a marijuana investigation; or
  - d. the applicant's household income in the year prior to application did not exceed an amount determined by rule of the state licensing authority; and
  - e. the social equity licensee, or collectively one or more social equity licensees, holds at least fifty-one percent of the beneficial ownership of the regulated marijuana business license

In closing, HB 1424 presents us with an opportunity to create a broader social equity program that will provide additional paths to participants who have encountered various barriers to entry into Colorado's marijuana industry. For these reasons, we ask for your support of HB 1424.
