We were supportive of Governor Polis' Executive Orders to allow temporary to go cocktails for the on-premises licensees to try to lessen the impacts to those businesses and deeply appreciate the Senate and House sponsors stated goals of a temporary statutory expansion of this license privilege.

CLBA supports SB20-213 as passed by the Senate which includes a Sunset date of July 1, 2021

This one-year sunset allows for a review of the recovery of the industry and provides the Colorado Department of Revenue Liquor Enforcement Division an opportunity to review impacts to on the entire liquor industry.
