

DUI PENALTIES  
(Offenses committed on or after July 1, 2010)

1<sup>st</sup> DUI/DUI Per Se

- 5 days-1 year jail (can be work release or in home detention)
- \$600-1,000 fine

1<sup>st</sup> DUI w/ BAC .2 or higher

- 10 days mandatory minimum- 1 year jail (can be work release or in home detention)
- \$600-1,000 fine

1<sup>st</sup> DWAI

- 2-180 days jail (can be work release or in home detention)
- \$200-500 fine

1<sup>st</sup> DWAI w/ BAC .2 or higher

- 10 days mandatory minimum- 1 year jail (can be work release or in home detention)
- \$200-500 fine

DUI, DWAI, or per se violation w/ prior (incl. other alc. related offenses)

- 10 days mandatory minimum- 1 year jail\*
- An additional 1 year jail suspended
- \$600-1,500 fine

DUI, DWAI, or per se violation w/ 2+ priors (incl. other alc. related offenses)

- 60 days mandatory minimum- 1 year jail\*
- An additional 1 year jail suspended
- \$600-1,500 fine

SENTENCING FOR F-4

- 2-6 years prison presumptive range
- \$2,000-500,000 fine

1288 would add (for the F-4):

- 90 days straight mandatory minimum; or
- 90-2 year work release

\* there are exceptions on sentencing alternatives like work release and in home detention.

Note: Sentences generally include a period of probation with some combination of an evaluation, treatment/education per the evaluation, community service, victim impact panel, use of an interlock device, alcohol monitoring, restitution, and costs.
