The American Association of University Women (AAUW) is one of the oldest women's organizations in the county, empowering women since 1881. Our public policy priorities underscore AAUW's mission to advance gender equity for women and girls through research, education and advocacy.

To guarantee individual rights AAUW supports freedom from violence and fear of violence.

At Colorado AAUW's annual Public Policy Day in 2018, we studied Human Trafficking 101 with presenters from Colorado's Human Trafficking Council and learned of the impacts of sexual violence and sexual abuse that often involve the victims, most often young women and children.

We support the update to this crime of violence, particularly recognizing evolving technology and the designation of an extraordinary risk crime against child victims under 12. We also support creating a surcharge on the penalty, not only because of the benefit to law enforcement, but because so often this crime involves financial benefits to a trafficker or other person controlling the victim.
