

Two Categories of Sex Colorado Sex Crimes:
Indeterminate and Determinate

Indeterminate sex crimes **require treatment and risk reduction prior to parole, if** the sentence is to prison:

- Felony sexual assault, including drug and alcohol facilitated sexual assault;
- Felony unlawful sexual contact by force;
- Sexual assault on a client by a psychotherapist or sexual misconduct by a police officer;
- Incest and aggravated incest;
- Sexual assault on a child, including sexual assault on a child by one in a position of trust;
- Enticement of a child;
- Felony internet luring or internet sexual exploitation of a child

Determinate sex crimes require treatment, but **treatment not required prior to parole, if** the sentence is to prison:

- Kidnapping for sexual purposes;
- Human trafficking for sexual servitude;
- Invasion of privacy for sexual gratification;
- Human trafficking of a minor for sexual servitude;
- Sexual exploitation of children (production, distribution, and possession of child pornography);
- Unlawful electronic sexual communication to a minor by one in a position of trust;
- Procurement of a child for sexual exploitation;
- Soliciting for child prostitution;
- Pandering of a child;
- Procurement of a child;
- Keeping a place of child prostitution;
- Pimping of a child;
- Inducement of child prostitution;
- Wholesale promotion of obscenity to a minor;
- Engaging in sexual conduct in a correctional institution;
- Felony indecent exposure
