I took my husband to the hospital on March 19. Six days later, he died. The only way we could see him was through FaceTime only two times (first time was when he was getting ready to be transported to another hospital and the second time was on the day that he died). When we were FaceTiming, he was sedated and could not talk both times. It was hard for me, our kids, and family because we were not allowed to see him. My husband died alone.

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**Fatima Angela** My husband spent 18 days in ICU due to CoVid19 they refused to allow us to visit also. I would go to the parking lot to pray and asked a nurse what window was his she made a cross out of tape on the window and there so happened to be a bench just under it and myself and kids climbed it to see him. I prayed and played music for him. He was suffering to breathe on the ventilator. Very tough to see. Security kicked us out twice 😞



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**Carol Bicking** I lost my husband on April 25, he was an hour from home visiting his uncle in a small town and the ambulance took him to the small town hospital they kept him breathing until I got there but they let me my 11 year old son and one year old twins in the room, his parents and uncle and his 2 cousins were all in the room too without even a question. I always wonder if he had been home and would have been taken to his university hospital, would he have survived or would we have been denied entry to say our goodbyes. Although it was heart shattering to see him lifeless like that I'm thankful our kids and I could be with him for his final moments. 😞 I'm so sorry you had to miss the opportunity.
