"SECTION 11. In Colorado Revised Statutes, 22-54-117, add

(1)(a)(IX) as follows:

22-54-117. Contingency reserve - fund - repeal. (1) (a) For the

2007-08 fiscal year and fiscal years thereafter, the general assembly shall annually determine the amount to appropriate to the contingency reserve fund, which is hereby created in the state treasury. In deciding the amount to appropriate to the contingency reserve fund, the general assembly may take into consideration any recommendations made by the department of education, but nothing in this section obligates the general assembly to provide supplemental assistance to all districts that are found to be in need or to fully fund the total amount of such need. The state board may approve and order payments from the contingency reserve fund for supplemental assistance to districts determined to be in need as the result of any or all of the following circumstances:

(IX) (A) FOR THE 2021-22, 2022-23, AND 2023-24 BUDGET YEARS, UNUSUAL FINANCIAL BURDEN CAUSED BY THE WITHHOLDING OF LOCAL PROPERTY TAXES PURSUANT TO SECTION 29-1-606 (5) FOR A RURAL OR SMALL RURAL SCHOOL DISTRICT, AS DEFINED IN SECTION 22-7-1211 (4), BECAUSE OF A DELAY IN FILING THE AUDIT REPORT DUE TO EXTRAORDINARY PROBLEMS THAT COULD NOT HAVE BEEN REASONABLY FORESEEN OR PREVENTED BY THE RURAL OR SMALL RURAL SCHOOL DISTRICT.
